



Free Emergency Medical Responder Training, \$500 Stipend If Volunteer

The Hospital District is offering free Emergency Medical Responder (EMR) training by instructors from Pine Technical & Community College. Area Fire Departments are in urgent need of more trained EMR professionals. **This is a \$1,450 value.** The \$700 tuition is waived and the Hospital District will pay the cost for \$160 books, \$20 CPR Card, \$80 EMR response bag and a \$500 stipend. To qualify, the person must be a resident of the Hospital District and commit to working as a volunteer for two years with one of the Hospital District Fire Departments.

The Hospital District area includes the cities of Hinckley, Sandstone, Askov, Bruno, Finlayson and Willow River as well as the Townships of Sandstone, Danforth, Hinckley, Park, Dell Grove, New Dosey, Partridge, Arlone, Pine Lake, Finlayson and Clover.

EMR professionals provide initial emergency care, usually first on the scene and support Emergency Medical Technicians and paramedics. Some of the skills taught include airway management/ventilation, patient assessment, obtaining vitals, splinting, bleeding control/tourniquet, shock management, head and spine emergencies, hazmat and much more.
